

WHY FIT TESTER TRAINING?

Prior to issuing respirators to workers, Employers are required to ensure a fit test is performed to demonstrate an effective facial seal with the wearer. Instead of hiring an external "Fit Tester," an Employer can have their own personnel perform internal fit testing for their workers.

However, assigned Fit Testers must be educated, trained and instructed in proper, industry-accepted protocols, according to <u>CSA Standard CAN/CSA-Z94.4-02</u>, <u>Selection</u>, <u>Use</u>, <u>and Care of Respirators</u>, to be considered "qualified" to perform fit tests. Do you assign respirators to your workers to protect them from air contaminants? Do you need an internal, trained Fit Tester?
