Manitoba Jobs Agreement(MJA) Update

Following the Provincial Governments announcement of the Manitoba Jobs Agreement (MJA) initiative in Budget 2025, the Government formalized the Agreement with Manitoba Building Trades September 16, 2025. The status of the MJA Framework may be found at the link below.

In response to the signing, MCAM formally requested industry consultation; highlighting, MCAM members construct and maintain essential systems and specialized operations within Manitoba's vertical infrastructure employing 14 (combined with ECAM) critical construction trades and ***authentic engagement and consultation with our diverse memberships is essential.***

Today, MCAM accepted the Departments invitation to participate in stakeholder engagement. Government has indicated this process will inform the development of the Manitoba Jobs Agreement (MJA) policy framework.

MCAM recognizes that, given the diversity of the industry, the MJA is an issue of considerable sensitivity for many members. In preparation for departmental engagement, the MCAM Board of Directors will undertake a line-by-line review of the Agreement in collaboration with ECAM. MCAM will provide timely updates to members and share clear, accurate information as additional details emerge.
