

January Board of Directors Meeting Highlights

The MCAM Board of Directors is comprised of a cross section of Industry members; Residential through Heavy Industrial, urban and rural, sub-contractors, engineers and associate members. The Board meets monthly September through June and is served by standing committees, advisory councils and working groups.

Manitoba Jobs Agreement (MJA) Update

Review of the Manitoba Jobs Agreement (MJA) is ongoing, with one-on-one contractor meetings having taken place. Amendment recommendations to the MJA team are currently underway. MCAM will continue advocating for the industry at both the political and operational levels of government.

2025 Model Codes

The 2025 Model Codes have been released. The Board was informed that the association was approached for consultation regarding changes and potential Manitoba amendments of the codes. MCAM Board members are invited to attend the consultation. The Executive Director suggested that the Model Codes could also serve as an educational topic for TradeConnect 2026.

Service and RACT Workforce Challenges

The Board discussed labour shortages among Service and RACT workers and the need for long-term solutions. The discussion also addressed immigration logistics and barriers, emphasizing the importance of being aware of the appropriate resources to support and guide immigrant workers.

Cash Allowance for Pulleys & Belts

The Board discussed cash allowance for pulleys, and belts relating to Testing and Balancing requirements. Consultants are being asked to include a cash allowance for these items, prompting questions regarding responsibility among equipment suppliers, TAB companies, and contractors, and who ultimately bears the cost. An update will be provided at the March meeting.
