# Delineation of Responsibilities for Contractors involved in BIM projects

The Board discussed BIM and the current challenges in contract agreements. Contracts are awarded stipulating drawings should be provided at the Level of Development (LUD) 300 stage, with Trade contractors responsible for advancing them to LUD 400. However, Trade Contractors are having to allocate overhead resources to bring drawings to LUD 300. MCAM will investigate best practices in markets whereby BIM is commonly adopted and will explore opportunities to educate its members and work with Industry partners.

The Board discussed the challenge of establishing cell phone policies for job sites. While cell phones are essential tools for certain roles, they pose hazards when not used safely. Balancing the need for communication with the potential hazards requires careful consideration in developing effective policies. MCAM will be researching Cellphone Best Practices.

Apprenticeship Manitoba is reviewing the unmet in-class training demand on a trade-by trade basis, working with the training providers to add additional seats for the April 1/24 - March 31/25 time frame. Demand is established by waitlists. It is imperative if your apprentice was unsuccessful in registering for training, they request their name be added.
