Advisory: Captive Air Unit Inspection and Warranty Update

MCAM representatives met with ITS to address concerns regarding installations of Captive Air units failing inspection. The failed inspections were based on installations being inconsistent with manufacturers' recommendations. ITS advised they have communicated with the manufacturer who will provide a letter confirming safety of the installation to pass inspection, however, this may impact the manufacturer warranty that accompanies the unit. Contractors are encouraged to follow installation recommendations and if adjustments are required ensure warranty coverage prior to installation.
