Prompt Payment SESSION

The Government of Manitoba introduced *Bill 28 – Prompt Payment for the Construction Industry* to address delayed payments impacting the construction industry.

On April 20 at the RBC Center in Winnipeg, Dan Leduc provided an overview of how Prompt Payment legislation dramatically decreases the time spent waiting for payments.

With the goal of cash neutrality; Dan understands “eliminating delays is key to profitability”. Dan also provided insight on the mechanics of Bill 28 and field industry questions.

This session was hosted by the Manitoba Prompt Payment Coalition; a coalition representing 32 Manitoba Trade Contractor Associations and Unions.
